Eatery chain plans to help troops

Moe's Southwest Grill locations in Shreveport and Bossier City are ending a drive to help troops with a weekend of sales where a slice of the proceeds will be used to prepare aid packages.

Moe's says it plans to donate 20 percent of total store sales to create care packages for U.S. soldiers in Iraq and Afghanistan.

For the last week, the eatery has been accepting monetary donations and care package items from customers seeking its signature burritos.

From 11 a.m. to 9 p.m. today and Saturday, the 20-percent slice from the healthy appetites of customers will be dedicated to the troops, with the care packages to be put together Sunday, starting at noon.

Moe's Southwest Grill locations are at 2300 Airline Drive in Bossier City and at 7141 Youree Drive in Shreveport.

The Moe's locations have partnered with anysoldier.com to encourage donations for the troops, a release from the company says.

Moe's Southwest Grill, based in Atlanta, was founded in December 2000 and currently has 800 franchise units signed, with 340 operating in 38 states.
